Date: August 2, 2024 RE: OCC Screen Rebuild

As part of ongoing maintenance activities at the Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) periodically the shafts and discs of various fiber screening conveyors need to be replaced. The OCC (cardboard) line at the MRF needs a complete rebuild, having had incremental repairs made over the last several years in an effort to try and make it through the commissioning of the new MRF.

Considering the delay of building the new MRF it has become apparent that the incremental repairs are not sufficient, and a complete rebuild is critical. Not only will this rebuild allow us to keep separating high-value OCC in the current MRF but will also likely increase the potential resale value of the screen on the secondary market after the new MRF is commissioned. The parts list is attached.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Board of Commissioners of the Chittenden Solid Waste District herby authorizes the Executive Director to purchase the necessary parts for a rebuild of the Materials Recycling Facilty OCC screen from Machinex Technologies, Inc. of Plessisville, Quebec for \$96,285.87.

Re: Personnel Rules & Regulations - Request to consider changing Paid Time Off

Background

CSWD offers paid time off to eligible employees. This time includes the following buckets of time:

- 1. holiday
- 2. holiday floater Bennington Battle Day
- 3. personal 16 hours per week
- 4. vacation
- 5. sick time
- 6. compensatory time (over 40 hours per week for non-exempt, or 45 hours for exempt employees)

Each July 1st full-time employees receive 16 hours of personal time, 8 hours of a Bennington Battle Day holiday, and a lump sum of vacation time. (Bennington Battle Day is a recognized holiday by the State of Vermont and CSWD has made the decision to not close facilities each August 16th). We would like to simplify the time off offered to employees by moving the Bennington Battle Day Floater (8 hours per year) and the two personal days (16 hours per year) into the vacation bucket. Combining these means less tracking for both CSWD and the employee. It would not increase the amount of time off.

However, the floater and the personal days are not paid out to an employee who leaves employment, and that time is not carried over from year to year. By moving those hours into the vacation bucket, the employee can carry over one time their vacation accrual (3 more days) and any employee who leaves and has remaining vacation time would be paid out.
