General Information

CSWD takes your privacy seriously. Please read the following information to learn more about our privacy practices.

This policy covers what personally identifiable information CSWD collects and how it is treated. Personally identifiable information is information that can be used to identify visitors to the cswd.net website. This information may be limited to an IP address or extend to personally identifiable information such as your name, address, email address, or phone number which you submit voluntarily.

Information Collection

When visiting websites certain information about you and your computer can sometimes be collected. This section explains what information CSWD collects, and how it is used.

Information Collected - What information do we collect and why?

CSWD collects different types of non-personally identifiable information that may include referral URLs, visitor IP addresses, visitor use of website, information about the browsers used by the visitor, etc. Some of this information is collected through cookies, which are small pieces of data that are sent to your browser from a web server and are stored on your computer's hard drive and help CSWD identify you as the user. You have the choice to modify your browser and thus to reject the website cookies.

We collect the following identifiable information about our visitors. Items marked (optional) are not collected by default and are only collected in specific forms with the explicit consent of the user.

We collect identifiable information to improve website and system administration, report on web analytics and perform research and development into aggregate user patterns and behaviors.

Our website generates server log files automatically. These log files are used to generate statistical information and error reports to ensure the Website runs with a minimum of disruption. They are not actively used to identify individual visitors.

Information Recipients - Who has access to the information collected?

Information Retention - How long is this information retained?

We do not have a retention policy for this area of the Website.

Third Party Cookies

If you interact with the content of our website, third-party cookies may also be installed (for example, by clicking on social media buttons or viewing videos hosted on other sites). They are established by a domain different than our website and are subject to the relevant websites policies. We cannot access the data stored in cookies of other websites when you browse these other websites.

This site uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics uses cookies to help us to analyze how users use the site. It counts the number of visitors and tells us things about their aggregate behavior overall such as the typical length of stay on the site or the number of pages an average user views.

Any information collected by cookies generated by Google Analytics are subject to the privacy policy of Google, Inc.

Cookies are not necessary for the use of our Website, so you can block or disable them by configuring your browser to allow you to block the installation of some or all cookies. Almost all browsers allow you to be alerted to the presence of cookies or block them automatically.

You can decide to withdraw your consent at any time by deleting the cookies on your computer (or mobile device) using the settings and configuration of your Internet browser.
